



SPECIALISATION: INTERNATIONAL ECONOMIC POLICY



During your studies, you will get acquainted with the principles governing the functioning of the EU and global markets. You will learn how to conduct a professional analysis and assessment of the situation in both the global and EU economy. You will gain knowledge about the strategies of companies on the international market. You will be able to develop a professional career in public institutions, government administration, international organisations and in business.



SPECIALISATION: ECONOMICS OF THE DIGITAL ECONOMY

The digital economy consists of goods and services whose development, production, sales or providing depend entirely on digital technologies. It is a global network of economic activities, operating thanks to the existence of information and communication technologies. This speciality is addressed to those who want to gain knowledge and develop a career in an innovative area at the interface between economy and information technology. During your studies, you will develop the competences of the future. You will gain knowledge on Industry 4.0, digital transformation, and contemporary, international, economic relations. Additional skills are of critical importance, so you will be able to develop your cognitive and analytical skills, helping you to search and select information, think critically, and establish relationships in a multicultural environment. The studies are addressed to those who are interested in professional development as database analysts, co-ordinators of intelligent services in enterprises, banks, and other organisations, or as specialists of new technologies.

SPECIALISATION: TRANSPORT ECONOMICS AND LOGISTICS

The programme opens up many employment opportunities and career prospects. You will gain thorough knowledge on the functioning of the latest solutions in transport and logistics, and about intelligent transport systems. You will learn how to optimise logistics processes in line with the principles of sustainability and environmental protection. You will gain practical knowledge about innovative supply chains, and learn how to organise and optimize transport in domestic and foreign companies. The studies are addressed to those who plan to run their own business in the field of international trade, future employees of customs agencies, logistics centres, sales departments in production and service companies, as well as to those who link their professional future with work in an international environment in the field of domestic and international forwarding, economics, and marketing.
