- **High School Diploma**
- **Transcript to High School Diploma**
- **Previous document of education** – basis for the admission to secondary school
- **Translations of all documents** (sworn translation into Polish or official translation into English).



Documents issued in **English, German, Spanish, Italian, Russian, Ukrainian, Belarusian** **DO NOT** require its translation.



- **Identity card / passport**
- **Declaration of a parent/legal representative** (if under 18) – **here**

Apostille/legalisation is **NOT** required for diploma recognition process.

- **Translations of all documents** (sworn translation into Polish or official translation into English).
